1 WHEREAS, recycling reduces waste and creates jobs;

2 AND WHEREAS, landfills are difficult to site, expensive to permit and construct, and recycling extends

3 the usable life of our permitted landfills;

4 AND WHEREAS, many cities in the state have successfully adopted curbside recycling programs;

5 AND WHEREAS, a fee paid by all residents increases participation and lowers the cost of the

6 program;

7 AND WHEREAS, every household in Missouri communities should have the availability of curbside

8 recycling services.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Conservation Federation of Missouri assembled at

10 the Lodge of Four Seasons, Lake Ozark, MO, this 27th day of February, 2010 supports the promotion of

11 Department of Natural Resources' Solid Waste Management Program and encourages the adoption of

12 curbside recycling in communities.
