Dear Big Game, Turkey, and Furbearer Resource Advisory Committee,

On the 3rd of October 2023, the Missouri Department of Conservation's (Department) furbearer working group reviewed your request to consider extending the muskrat and river otter trapping seasons to run concurrently with the beaver trapping season. After reviewing your suggestion, reviewing recent changes to regulations for these species, and the reasoning for why the dates were set for muskrats and otters in the past, the working group recommended the current trapping season regulations should not be changed. Members of the Regulations Committee were presented the working group's recommendation at a meeting on December 12, 2023.

In the last several years, the muskrat and river otter seasons were extended to the end of February, providing two additional weeks of opportunity for trappers. The season was not extended past the end of February because of the potential for harvesting a female of either species with dependent young, which ethical trapping practices dictate should be avoided. The recent changes to muskrat and otter trapping regulations and the biological implication of extending the season were the main reasons why the working group did not recommend changing the regulations.
